Dear Parents/Guardians,

Junior and Intermediate students will be participating in the annual Mountain View Science Fair. The goal of this project is to help students learn about the Scientific Process, use the Inquiry Process to explore aspects of Science and Technology that are of particular interest to them, and develop effective communication skills.

Students may choose to work individually or with a partner from the same grade (with teacher and parental consent). Students will be expected to give a brief oral explanation of their projects to the class and to science fair judges. Family and friends are invited to view the projects on **Wednesday, February 20, 2019**, in the school gym, from 3:20 pm to 7:00pm. Some of the projects from our school fair will be selected to take part in the County Science Fair in Barrie, on Friday, March 29 and Saturday, March 30. There will be a registration fee for the county fair.

All students should visit www.simcoecountyrstf.ca to see rules & regulations for projects at the County Science Fair. **There are strict rules for experiments involving humans or animals, so please read regulations thoroughly if you plan to do an experiment that does!**
